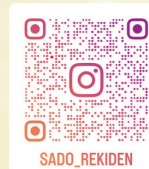

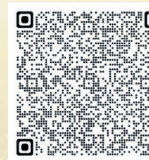

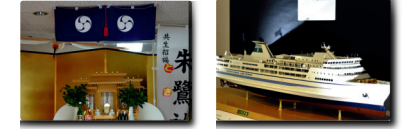
The Legend of the Vendetta for His Father, Hino Suketomo

Toki Shrine is a shrine known for improving financial luck, originating from the local ties of Toki no Sato, a village where crested ibises were fed. Let's pray for good financial fortune. 9 Souvenir Shop & Toki Cafe

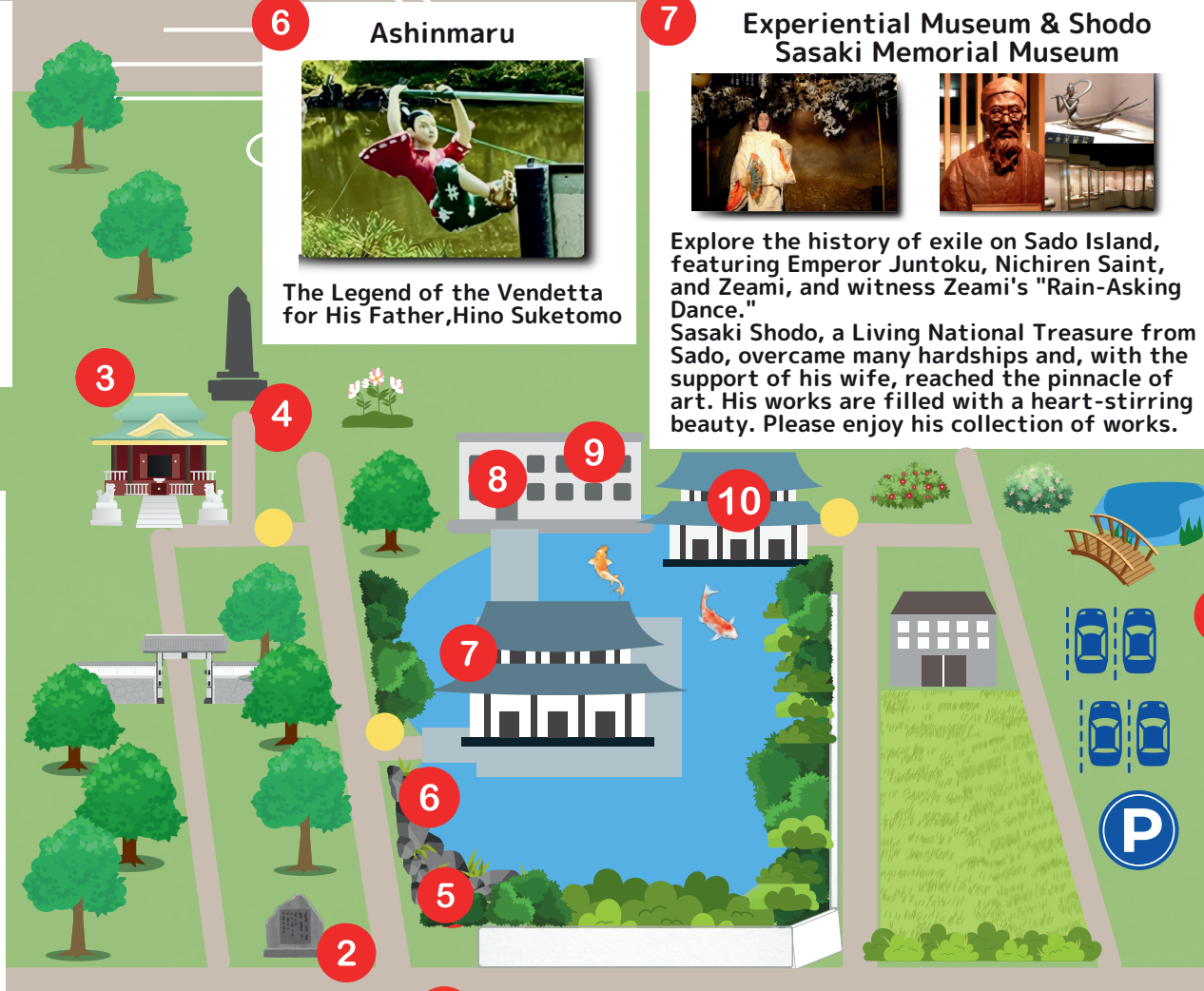
